All the Mobile Numbers should be withheld from publication and only those who wish to get their numbers published may do so by communicating with NIDQS. [Customer Communication with NIDQS appointed agencies may begin well in advance so that they will have some data when the directory goes Live] We have already seen in case of NDNCRegistry that people who have registered [including myself] still receive tele-marketing calls. Though listing in NIDQS is not that a serious issue but we should still learn from our past lessons.
